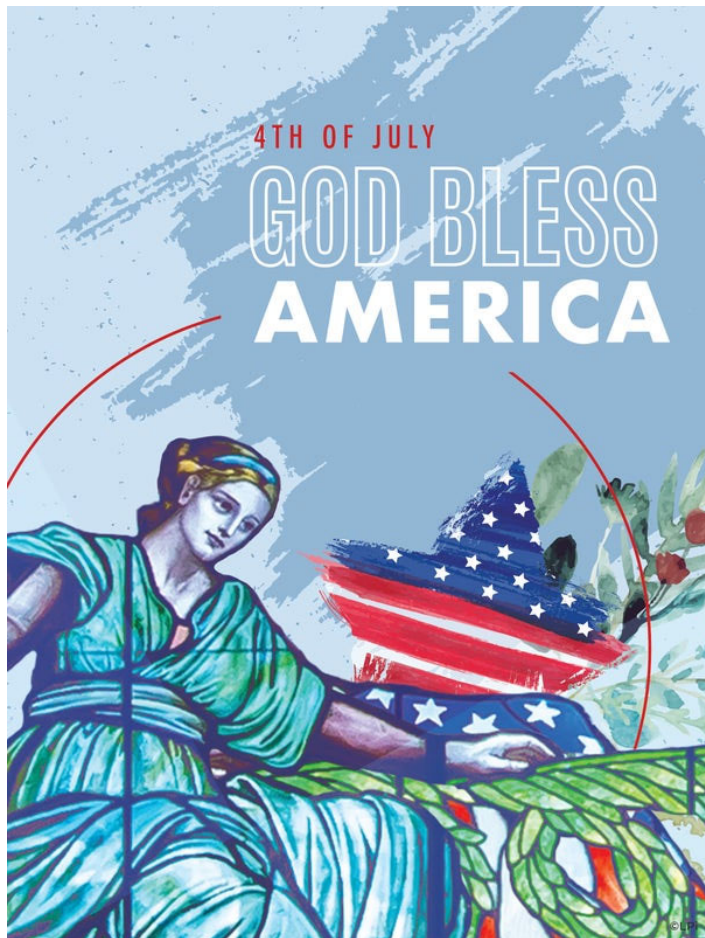

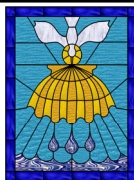
THIS WEEK ON FORMED

 Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901–1925), re-released in
 honor of his 2025 canonization. Frassati was a joyful,
 athletic young man from a wealthy Italian family who
 gave his life in service to the poor, the sick, and the mar-
 ginalized as a powerful witness of Christian charity. An
 avid mountain climber and leader in Catholic youth and
 social action, he died of polio at 24, leaving a lasting leg-
 acy of faith and joy.
